Comparisons by Demographic Subgroups

2018



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Summary

The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS™) is a collaborative effort between National Research Center, Inc. (NRC) and the International City/County Management Association (ICMA). The survey and its administration are standardized to assure high quality research methods and directly comparable results across The NCS communities. This report discusses differences in opinion of survey respondents by length of residency, household income, age and race/ethnicity.

Responses in the following tables show only the proportion of respondents giving a certain answer; for example, the percent of respondents who rated the quality of life as "excellent" or "good," or the percent of respondents who attended a public meeting more than once a month. ANOVA and chi-square tests of significance were applied to these comparisons of survey questions. A "p-value" of 0.05 or less indicates that there is less than a 5% probability that differences observed between subgroups are due to chance; or in other words, a greater than 95% probability that the differences observed are "real." Where differences were statistically significant, they have been shaded grey.

The margin of error for all respondents (360) is generally no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent. The margin of error for subgroups is less precise. For subgroups of approximately 100 respondents, the margin of error is plus or minus 10 percentage points.

Notable differences between demographic subgroups included the following:

- Community Characteristics and Governance ratings related to Recreation and Wellness tended to increase with age of respondent; however Participation in Recreation and Wellness activities tended to decrease with age of respondent.
- Residents who had lived in Paducah for more than 20 years tended to offer the lowest ratings to general aspects of local governance and leadership compared to their counterparts (i.e., the overall direction that Paducah is taking, overall confidence in Paducah government, etc.).
- When residents assessed their willingness to pay a monthly fee to provide funding for improvements to the stormwater drainage system, those who had lived in the community for five years or less, were younger (18-34) or who had annual household incomes above \$50,000 were more likely than their counterparts to be willing to pay a fee.
