Member Wainscott Offered the following Motion:

I move that this Commission find as fact that the proposed improvements at 422 N. 7th Street be dened:

- 1. Use of cellular pvc for wood and door trim.
- 2. Use of ceullular pvc or exterior siding in gable areas

I move that a Certificate of Appropriateness be given to:

- 1. Use cellular pvc for soffits, fasica, flashing, and exterior trim, excluding windows and doors. Cellular pvc must be smooth faced with non-glossy finish.
- 2. Use wood or smooth faced cement fiberboard on gable areas
- 3. Use wood or smooth faced cement fiberboard on window and door trim.

I move that the proposed improvements conform with the standard of historical integrity set forth in Section 126-115 of the Paducah Zoning Ordinance and that this Commission specifically finds as fact that:

• The proposed action is in harmony with the wording and intent of the Ordinance;

- The proposed action is complementary to all conforming structures within the zone; and
- The proposed action is in conformity and complies with a majority of the design guidelines and Secretary of Interior Standards for Rehabilitation.
