Dear Resident:

Below are the eligibility rules for residents to receive service assistance and need you to provide verification that you qualify. To qualify for this program residents must meet the following standards:

- Be permanently or temporarily physically disabled (requires a doctor's statement).
- There cannot be anyone residing in the resident over the age of twelve (12) years, who is able to transport the trash container to the collection place.

Please complete and sign the attached form and return it with the required documentation to Engineering Public Works.

If qualified for the service assistance, your trash collection day will not change; however, the container must be placed at an accessible place for the driver to get it. **City employees cannot enter garages, enclosed locked fences, or enclosed areas where a pet is running loose.**

The following information must be provided along with this form:

- **A statement from a licensed physician signifying that the applicant (and all household residents) is/are permanently or temporarily physically disabled to the extent that they cannot transport their trash to the curb for collection.**
- The applicant must further signify that there is no one residing in the residence over the age of twelve (12) years, who is able to transport the trash container from the residence to the designated collection place. Periodic visits will be made to the residence to validate this requirement. The City will discontinue the service anytime they find that the resident does not meet the program requirements.

Qualified residents will be given (or retain) a blue container. On the resident's collection day, the blue container must be placed at an accessible place for the driver to get the container. **City employees cannot enter garages, enclosed locked fences, or enclosed areas where a pet is running loose. Employees are not responsible if pets get out of an enclosed area.**
