**Paducah Parks Services: Summer Programs
New Episode on Government Channel 11**

PADUCAH, KY— From sports leagues to swimming lessons, summer camps, and special events, Paducah Parks Services has programs for all ages this summer. Government 11, the government access channel of the City of Paducah, has a new episode of *Paducah Parks Services* that begins airing Wednesday, May 26. The episode focuses on summer programs, the Noble Park Pool, and the disc golf course at Stuart Nelson Park.

For the first segment of the episode, Public Information Officer Pam Spencer interviews Recreation Specialists Amie Clark and John Gorrell about the variety of sports leagues, summer camps, and special events available for summer 2010.

During the second segment of *Paducah Parks Services: Summer Programs*, find out what it takes to get the Noble Park Pool ready for the summer swimming season. Park Maintenance Superintendent Trace Stevens provides an overview of the pool's pump and filtration systems. Also, there's an interview with Greg Williams who will be coaching the Paducah Sting Rays. The Sting Rays are a competitive swimming team for ages 4 through 18 that will practice at the Noble Park Pool. Tryouts for the Sting Rays will be June 1 at 6:00 p.m.

For the final segment of *Paducah Parks Services: Summer Programs*, Pam Spencer and John Gorrell travel to Stuart Nelson Park where Gorrell gives Spencer a disc golf lesson. Stuart Nelson Park is home to Paducah's 18-hole disc golf course that opened in 2007. The sport is growing across the area with the opening of several other regional courses.
