What can I expect from Public Works during my Rise & Shine Week?

- **Yellow Rollout Containers** Look for the yellow rollout containers located around the neighborhood. Place bags of garbage in them. They will be emptied by the Public Works Department and removed at the end of the neighborhood's Rise & Shine Week.
 - o **DO NOT** overfill the rollout containers. They will be emptied often.
 - o **DO NOT** put household hazardous waste* in them.
- **Dumpsters** Check http://paducahky.gov/southside-rise-and-shine to find out where the Public Works Department has placed a dumpster(s) for the neighborhood.
 - o **DO** put garbage and bulky items (such as chairs) in the dumpster.
 - DO NOT put household hazardous waste* or tires in the dumpster.
 - DO NOT leave items outside the dumpster.
- Curbside/Streetside Crews will collect (at no charge) bulky items left curbside or streetside.
 - o **DO** put furniture and tires curbside or streetside.
 - o **DO** put appliances curbside or streetside.
 - o **DO** call Public Works at 270-444-8511 if you have bulky items for collection.
- **Limbs and Yard Debris** Place curbside or near edge of roadway.
 - o **DO NOT** place in alleys, curbs and gutters, or ditches.
 - o **DO NOT** place under utility lines or block streets, storm drainage systems, or fire hydrants.
- Street Sweeper Look for the street sweeper on streets with curbs and gutters.

^{*}What is household hazardous waste? Light bulbs, fluorescent bulbs, insecticides, weed killers, cleaners, paint, batteries, used motor oil, mercury filled items, etc. Also, do not include ammunition, medications, medical waste, commercial waste, or radioactive items.
